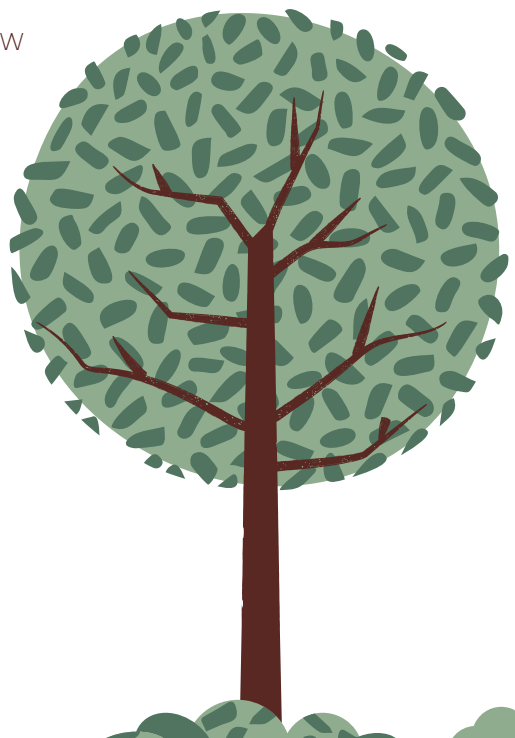


## Community Manager
